

grow to 20' in height) approximately 6' tall and planted on a berm which is currently around building 6. All were in agreement that nothing could be done until spring 2018. In the meantime the Commission requested that all tall items that are currently being stored outdoor (such as Rv's) be relocated to behind building 3, and only the shorter items (such as snowmobile trailers) be parked behind building 6. Mr. Ransavage is to submit a new plan to the Commission for review at the January 16, 2018 meeting that includes a completion date. The Commission also disallowed any new outdoor storage until the Conditional Use Permit Amendment is completed and approved.
