### TOWN OF BLOOMFIELD TO HOLD TWO PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETINGS ABOUT REFERENDUM

*Open House style meetings scheduled for Thursday, February 13 and Tuesday, March 10*

*Advisory April 7 Referendum will ask Town residents "Should the Town enter into a boundary agreement which would transfer the entire Town to the Village of Bloomfield?"*

**BLOOMFIELD, Wis. (January 13, 2020)** – Town of Bloomfield officials have confirmed that two open house meetings have been set to provide information and answer questions about the April 7 referendum. Meetings will be held at the Town/Village Hall from 5:30 PM until 7 PM each evening. These open houses are intended to allow interested residents to stop in anytime during that period to speak with Town and Village representatives as the Town considers a boundary agreement which would eliminate the boundary with the Village of Bloomfield and transfer the entirety of the Town to the Village. A recent news article published a different date for the first meeting.

"We want people to be clear about the referendum question they will see when they go to the polls on April 7 and understand what it means to them. We will have illustrations, handouts, and representatives from the Town and Village of Bloomfield around the room to talk with attendees one on one. We want to respectfully explain what re-uniting the Town and Village means and respond to residents' questions," said Town Chairman Dan Schoonover.
